## **Deer Park Driving School Policies and Procedures**

1. Washington state requires that students be 15 years old minimum by the first day of class

### 2. Course package and expectations

- o Minimum length of 5 weeks and must be completed within 9 months
- 30 hours of classroom instruction
- 5 hours behind-the-wheel instructional drives
- o 1 hour observation drive
- o 4 hours of driving simulation in lieu of a 6th behind-the-wheel instructional drive
- o Passing score of a minimum 80% on all assessments, including the course final

#### 3. Course Fees

- Course fee is \$625; \$100 non-refundable deposit is due at time of registration, the remaining balance by the 1st day of class
- o Refunds are allowed up until 48 hours before the first class
- o A \$50 fee will incur for the following reasons:
  - i. Not showing up for an instructional drive
  - ii. Showing up for drives without a permit
  - iii. Having to repeat an instructional drive
- o Fees must be paid before another drive can be scheduled
- o \$90 1-hour instructional drive (lessons outside of drivers ed)

## 4. Testing Fees

- \$30 DOL state knowledge test
- \$50 DOL state skills test; personal vehicle
- \$70 DOL state skills test; Deer Park Driving School vehicle

#### 5. Classroom Attendance

- o Course enrollment cannot occur after the 3rd session of class
- Late students will not be accepted into classes, that day would be counted as absent
- No more than 3 classes may be missed; no penalty fee for missing classes
- o Any missed classes must be made up; call or email for make up dates

#### 6. Course Failure and Repeats

- Failing to complete the course final within three attempts or the whole course within
  9 months
- If more than 3 classes are missed, the student will be disenrolled from the course without a refund; to re-enroll, a new course fee is required and sessions start over
- Expulsion will occur for inappropriate behavior, inattentiveness, using non-inclusive language, cheating, or evidence of illegal drug or alcohol use. Expulsion is at the discretion of the school; this will result without the possibility of refund or re-enrollment

#### 7. Classroom Guidelines

- o Parent/guardian meeting is the first hour of class on the first day
- Phones and other electronic devices should be turned off or down
- Students will be held responsible for any damage to supplies and/or equipment caused by mistreatment or careless behavior

- 8. Behind-The-Wheel Guidelines
  - The instructional permit is required for instructional drives; showing up for a drive without a permit is considered a no show and applicable fees will apply
  - o Drives start and finish at our school location
  - The observational drive may be scheduled by phone, email, or in person and must be completed prior to the last class session
  - Allow for at least 5 days between instructional drives for practice time
  - Students are required to meet the level 3 minimum standard in order to get credit for a drive; criteria expectations are attached in the parent's night email
  - o Drives that do not meet the standard will have to be made up; fees apply
  - o Four hours of driving simulation are required and included in the curriculum
- 9. Consent for audio/visual recording
  - o Vehicles, classrooms/testing areas are recorded for safety and training purposes
  - o Data remains private; it will not be shared with the general public
  - o By signing this form you are granting Deer Park Driving School permission & consent to record
